Hosted by the small farmer organizations from international farmer movement CLOC/La Via Campesina  
Federación de Cooperativas de la Reforma Agraria de la Región Central (FECORACEN)  
& Central Nacional de Trabajadores del Campo (CNTC)

**Join us for this unique opportunity to visit organizations of the world's largest peasant movement, La Via Campesina.**

This delegation will take place in two countries that are part of the Mesoamerican region, known for the traditional milpa planting system based around corn, beans, and squash. We will begin our journey along the Pacific Ocean on lands tilled by peasant cooperatives as part of El Salvador's agrarian reform. Today these farms serve as sites for national and regional training processes in agroecology for the Via Campesina movement. Our delegation will then travel to Honduras to visit communities living on lands recovered from terratenientes (large corporate landholders) and who grow on diversified plots with coffee, fruits, vegetables, and animals. Participants will see first-hand in both countries the challenges of the current political context and what popular organizations are doing to defend and feed their communities.

Joining the delegation will be representatives from Via Campesina organizations in the region.

Thursday August 20th - Sunday August 23rd: program in Honduras hosted by CNTC

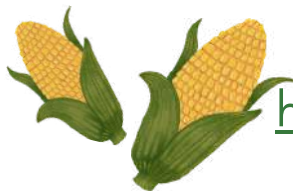
Monday August 24th: return trips from Comayagua Palmerola International Airport and/or onward destinations
